On February 20, 2008, at about 7:45 AM, a male Oakland resident was in the 1800 block of 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue. A male juvenile approached him and demanded money. The male refused to give the juvenile money and the juvenile began hitting the male. On the third swing at the male, the juvenile slipped and fell to the ground allowing the victim to run away. The victim said that three males chased him. The juveniles were unable to catch the male.

Oakland Public School Resource Officers responded to the victim's place of business and viewed video surveillance of the incident. Upon viewing the video, the School Resource Officers recognized two of the juveniles as students at Fremont High School. Oakland Public Schools Officer Bellusa responded to the school and took the juveniles into custody. A field show up was conducted and the victim identified one of the juveniles as the person who hit him and the other male as one of the juveniles who ran up to him after the incident. Both juveniles were arrested and transported to the Robbery Section for questioning.

One juvenile was questioned and found not to be involved in the attempt robbery. The other juvenile was admonished and gave a statement admitting his involvement in the attempted robbery.
