On March 4, 2008 at 11:30 PM, an armed robbery occurred in the 400 block of 38th Street. Two Oakland residents were robbed. There were two suspects, one was armed a firearm. The victims made a police report describing the suspects and the car used to flee 38th Street.

On March 5, 2008 at 12:46 AM, Sergeant Ortiz pulled over a car for running a stop sign. The two occupants and the car matched descriptions broadcast after the robbery. The two victims were brought to the location of the car stop. The two victims identified the occupants as the two men that robbed them. No weapon or loss items were found in the car. After a preliminary investigation the suspects were taken into custody. A callout was authorized and the suspects were transported to the Criminal Investigation Division to be interviewed.

The investigators conducted interviews with the two suspects. Both denied committing the robbery. This investigation is ongoing. Anyone with information is asked to contact the investigators at (510) 238-3326.
