On March 26th, 2008, at about 6:18 AM, Officers D. Pullen and D. Salcido responded to a possible auto burglary in progress in the 9700 block of Mountain Blvd. Upon arrival officers contacted a subject matching the suspect's description located near the victim vehicle. A witness reported seeing the suspect, later identified as Jacob Scott, a 36 year old Concord resident, inside the victim vehicle. Officers responding to the scene took Scott into custody. He is currently on probation for 12031 (a) (1) PC. Scott's identification was found in a nearby vehicle where officers located what appeared to be stolen property. Further investigation revealed items found on the car was loss from another burglary in the city of Menlo Park. Scott was arrested and transported to Criminal Investigation Division for interview where he refused to speak with investigators. Scott was transported to North County Jail for booking on charges of stolen property, possession of burglary tools, tampering with a vehicle and an outstanding warrant.
