On March 29th, 2008, at approximately 6:30 P.M., Oakland Police officers responded to the 900 block of 34th Street to investigate the report of a shooting. A male Black Oakland resident was shot one time in the pelvic area. The victim was transported to the Alameda County Hospital (ACH) where he was treated for the gunshot wound and listed in stable condition. There was a witness to this incident who on-viewed the shooting. Apparently the suspect and the victim are related. The suspect was identified as a male adult Oakland resident.

The suspect was later positively identified in a photographic line-up as Gregory Jackson, a 28 year old male Black Oakland resident. The suspect is still outstanding.
