The incidents occurred after the Super Bowl on Sunday, January 26, 2003. The Oakland Police Department now has still photos of several of these suspects. The photos are available to the media. Crime Stoppers is offering to pay up to \$1,000 dollars for information leading to the full identity of the suspects.
