Oakland Kidnapping Suspect Taken Into Custody After 5 Day Search By Police

OAKLAND, September 17—On September 13, 2004 at 9:16 a.m., Oakland Police Officers were called to 2014 5th Avenue #115 to investigate a report of a kidnapping. Upon arrival, officers made contact with the mother of 19-year-old Janae Rice. She stated that her daughter had been kidnapped. She explained that Rice had been involved in a dating relationship with 28-year-old Alfred Nunnery. They have a 9-month-old in common. Ms. Rice had been in the process of obtaining a restraining order against Nunnery for an incident of domestic violence that occurred the previous week.

Earlier that morning, Rice's mother went to visit her at her apartment on 5th Avenue. As she drove up to her daughter's residence, she observed her daughter being chased by Nunnery from the apartment. In an effort to get away from Nunnery, Janae got into her mother's vehicle. Nunnery also entered the vehicle and produced a handgun. Nunnery threatened to kill everyone in the car. A short time later, Rice's mother was released and returned to her daughter's apartment where she called the Oakland Police Department.
